On April 28th, workers, families and employees will gather at commemorative ceremonies across the province to honour BC workers who lost their lives last year due to workplace injury and disease and to renew our commitment to creating safer workplaces.

Over forty years ago, CUPE members created this day to remember workers who lost their lives on the job and to inspire others to advocate to prevent further tragedies.

Questions and Answers

- Q: SD43: Will we be receiving a 6.75% raise in July?
- A: Yes, after the Cost of living index was done in March, it was over 7% so that entitles the SD43 Employees a 6.75% raise.
- **Q:** When is the SD43 collective agreement coming out?
- A: It is already on our cupe561.ca website. There will be copies sent to sites in the next week and the CUPE 561 office has copies for any member that would like to pick one up.
- Q: Can the employer make us do unsafe work?
- A: NO, every employee has the right to refuse unsafe work. That includes dealing with members of the public. You keep yourself safe first.
- Q. Do we have to give first aid to public or students?
- A: First aid providers on the work site are for staff only. They are not meant to be providing first aid to the public or students.
