On April 28th, workers, families and employees will gather at commemorative ceremonies across the province to honour BC workers who lost their lives last year due to workplace injury and disease and to renew our commitment to creating safer workplaces.

Over forty years ago, CUPE members created this day to remember workers who lost their lives on the job and to inspire others to advocate to prevent further tragedies.

# Questions and Answers

- Q: If I injure myself at work, and enter my absence as WCB into the dispatch system or on my injury report, will the Employer file a WorkSafe claim on my behalf.
- A: No, employees should do the following when they injure themselves at work:
  - 1. Report your injury immediately to your supervisor and compete an injury report.
  - 2. See your physician.
  - 3. Report your injury to WorkSafe as soon as possible on line or by calling 1-888-WORKERS.
- Q: I'm a Caretaker and I would like to take a leave for approximately 8 weeks. If I take a 60 day leave, can I return to work before 60 days or do I need to use all 60 days?
- A: You do not have to use all 60 days, the language under Article 6.3.D. ii (C states "up to 60 days". Employees would need to notify the Employer of when they plan on returning.
