I have enjoyed my time as Senior Shop Steward and the opportunity it has given me to learn and help our members.

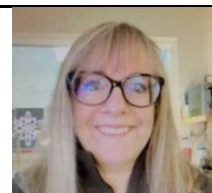
I have been avidly seeking many avenues of information from CUPE training to researching leading legal cases that set precedents for our fields of work.
